Often, states have opted to establish more than one step in the respective dispute-resolution mechanism, structuring the processes in two instances with different mechanisms to be applied. The Convention obliges Parties to prevent, control and reduce water pollution. Thus, insufficient freshwater access mainly can be seen as a problem of allocation and mismanagement.
